Overview

The Jeanneau Yachts 55 rethinks how a sailing yacht's interior is divided: the forward owner's suite occupies fully two-thirds of the interior, accessed privately via the main companionway, while two guest cabins aft are each reached by their own separate companionway from the cockpit for genuinely independent living.

On deck, a dual-cockpit layout dedicates the aft space to relaxation — two convertible saloons and a hydraulic swim platform — while the forward sailing cockpit has twin helms, an exterior chart table, and a hardtop wraparound windscreen for all-weather visibility.
