Overview

Designed by Philippe Briand with interiors by Andrew Winch, the Jeanneau Yachts 60 is built for owners who want a fully customizable blue-water cruiser. Up to 19 possible interior layouts let buyers configure everything from owner's cabin placement to galley and chart table position.

On deck, expansive decks and multiple lounging zones give room to spread out, and a longitudinal tender garage aft accommodates a 2.9m tender with a 15 hp engine — a genuinely useful feature for extended cruising away from marinas.

- Up to 19 configurable interior layouts
- Longitudinal tender garage with 15 hp tender capacity
- Twin rudders and an L-shaped keel with bulb for stability
- Choice of standard or shoal draft keel
- Multiple rig and sail options: classic, furling, self-tacking jib
- Optional skipper cabin forward for crewed voyages
