The flybridge version of Jeanneau's popular NC 1095 — the same 34-foot hull with an added upper helm and sundeck for extra living space.

Overview

The NC 1095 Fly takes the standard NC 1095 — already known for packing three double cabins into a 34-foot hull — and adds a full flybridge accessible directly from the deck. Twin 300 hp Yamaha outboards push it to a comfortable 25-knot cruise, with a top end around 35 knots.

The layout keeps everything that makes the NC line work for families: recessed side decks for safe movement, a large L-shaped cockpit lounge that converts to a sundeck at anchor, and flush floorboards that keep the transition between interior and exterior seamless.

Standard Highlights

- XXL flybridge with forward sundeck and folding copilot bench
- Large L-shaped cockpit lounge, converts to sundeck or small saloon
- Optional 3rd cabin that doubles as extra storage
- Recessed side decks with aft sliding door and skylights
- 360-degree wheelhouse visibility with opening sunroofs
- Outboard power keeps the cabin notably quiet underway

Best fit: couples and families who want to weekend and occasionally overnight on the Bay without stepping up to the larger, pricier NC 1295 Fly.
