Overview

The NC 895 Sport shares its platform with the 895 Series II but is built around versatility: a modular cockpit, an optional roof rack for paddleboards and kayaks, and a wide starboard-side boarding door — a rarity in this size class — for easy water access.

Twin Yamaha outboards, available in 200 or 250 hp, fold into a dedicated aft compartment for maintenance while keeping the cockpit clear. Below, two fully enclosed cabins offer six feet of headroom, and the forward salon table converts into an extra berth.

Standard Highlights

- Wide starboard-side boarding door for easy water access
- Optional cockpit roof rack for kayaks and paddleboards
- Engines fold into a dedicated aft compartment
- Fully enclosed wheelhouse with sliding doors both sides
- Galley with sink, gas stove, and 17-gallon fridge
- Forward salon table converts to an extra berth

Best fit: active families who prioritize water toys and day-to-day versatility over overnight cabin space.
