The newest and smallest Sun Odyssey — a pocket cruiser that sails big and brings the walk-around deck to a 34-foot hull.

Overview

Replacing the best-selling Sun Odyssey 349 (nearly 1,000 hulls sold), the 350 is an all-new Marc Lombard design with an inverted bow that clears the waterline for easier docking and better light-wind control. It's 3 inches beamier than its predecessor to make room for Jeanneau's walk-around deck at this smaller size.

Twin helms with off-centered aft positions improve forward visibility, and the helmsperson can reach the forward deck without disturbing passengers in the cockpit. Below, the saloon and two cabins are bathed in light from wide hull and coachroof windows, with an optional third cabin available by converting the saloon seating.

Standard Highlights

- Walk-around side decks — a first for a boat this size in the line
- Inverted bow for easier docking and light-wind handling
- Off-centered twin helms improve forward visibility
- Generous aft swim platform, accessible from the cockpit
- Three keel options: deep fin, shoal, or lifting/swing keel
- Optional third cabin via convertible saloon day bed

Best fit: entry-level and downsizing buyers who want genuine Sun Odyssey sailing characteristics and Bay-friendly ICW clearance (52 ft air draft) without the size or price of the 410 and up.
